## 3RD STOP IS THE RED ROOF INN

Plan to depart from the restaurant around 2:30 to fuel stop roughly 100 miles away. Then will head down to the Red Roof Inn in Hilton Head, SC for a fun night. There are several restaurants around. The one we are looking at is the Hilton Head Diner. Total from BJ to Hotel is 138 miles. Should arrive at Hotel about 6 to 7PM. Total miles for the day should be about 317 miles.
